In an ongoing revitalization of historic downtown Villa Rica, our newest addition to this area is THE MILL -- a 1,200 capacity "green space" amphitheater where concerts, community theater, classic/street rod car shows, movie nights, a farmers' market and numerous annual events are scheduled. In May 2011, we will begin the season with THE MILL's one-year anniversary celebration and continue through summer with our ever popular Summer Concert Series. We are proud to announce that we will be home to the Thomas Dorsey Birthplace Festival in June (formerly held at Gold Dust Park). These concerts and annual events enhance tourism, community pride, promote community involvement and build a sense of belonging.



With the help of the city's Historic Preservation Committee, city council and countless others, the city received \$400,000 in SPLOST funds provided by the Carroll County Board of Commissioners for green space at the former location of the Coca Cola Bottling Company and later Golden City Hosiery Mill. This grassy, three-terraced venue includes a state-of-the-art stage, concession building/ticket booth and public restrooms.

THE MILL serves to encourage visitors and citizens to spend more time in the downtown area, which provides increased visibility for local shops and restaurants and improves the quality of life for Villa Rican's and tourists. Benefits for the community include increased tax revenue and more business for merchants, restaurants and hotels. Every town or city needs a location that is considered a central gathering place for activity and energy. Our new amphitheater is downtown Villa Rica's central gathering place.
